

SEPARATION AND DISPOSAL OF DOMESTIC GARBAGE

Garbage which cannot be put out for collection or which cannot be taken to garbage processing centers	HARL items: Refrigerators • freezers, washing machines, televisions, air conditioners, electric (clothes) dryer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Items which fall under the Household Appliance Recycling Law (HARL) → contact the store where the goods were purchased. ● For collection of personal computers, contact the manufacturer. ● For disposal of two-wheeled motor vehicles (including mopeds), contact the seller. ● Request collection of tires, fire extinguishers and batteries from the store of purchase ● Please ensure branches and logs are under 10 cm in diameter and no longer than 50 cm in length for disposal. ● Contact your local hospital or pharmacy for medical waste collection.









- Drain excess water from kitchen waste.
 - Soak up used cooking oil in waste paper or cloth.
 - Notes, memos and (paper) sweet boxes that are bigger than a visit card can be recycled. Put them between the pages of a magazine or leaflet before disposal.
 - Remove earth from grass before disposal.
 - Remove waste from paper diapers.
 - For clothing disposal, place up to 2 bags at the collection point.
 - Cut cord-shaped garbage down to 1m.
- Only pruned branches, wood products, bamboo/bamboo products and tough vegetable stems can be tied with string instead of disposed in bags. Each item must be no more than 50cm long and 10cm wide. In total, wood and garden waste limited to 2 bags/bundles per disposal.
- Dispose of agricultural waste (stalks, leaves, vines, seeds) in the rice fields.
 - As for clothing, there is a collection site at each paper recycling station (please refer to the blue box on the lower right side of this page).
 - We ask for your cooperation in recycling cooking oil.
 - *The second Sunday of every month at Minami-shisho (Minowa-machi ha 84-2)
 - *The third Sunday of every month at Recycling Plaza (Mukaimotoori-machi he 88)
 - *Furugami recycle station (Ashida machi 2-7-1. From Mon. to Sat., from 8:30 to 16:30)
 - **Check other recycling sites in your town

- Place **Plastic containers and packaging** separately from **General garbage** at disposal area.
- Suitable items display the ♻️ mark.
 - Please remove the cap from all containers.
 - Clean items only.
 - Make sure all items are completely dry before disposal.
 - Plastic tube containers which are hard to clean (ketchup, mayonnaise, toothpaste, hair dye) and food wrappers go with the general garbage.

Cans that are above this size must be disposed of as Metals.</p> <p>● Empty all packaging and rinse all cans with water.</p> <p>● Exhaust all spray cans or tabletop cassette-style gas canisters in a well-ventilated place and puncture a hole in the side.</p>  	
	<p>METALS</p>	<p>Pans, kettles, frying pans, hot plates, oven toaster gas rice cookers, fan heaters, oil heaters, gas cookers, antennas, ski poles, golf clubs, sickles, knives, hoes.</p>				<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Remove batteries and kerosene from appliances before disposal. ● Glass lids must be disposed of as Landfill garbage. ● Heat treated metal and cast metal items are included in this category. ● Knives and blades must be wrapped with paper before disposal. ● Objects that are mostly made of metal, and whose size are under 150 cm in diameter or length may be disposed of as Metals even if they are in the list of 77 designated Large-size garbage.

Ex: a belt (leather and metal), an umbrella (metal and plastic or cloth) etc. ● Remove fluorescent bulb from lamps. ● Remove batteries from appliances before disposal. ● If the internal part of the electric rice cooker is made of metal, the disposal of each part is on different days (the internal part goes with Metals and the external part goes as Crush garbage).

At least one week before the collection:

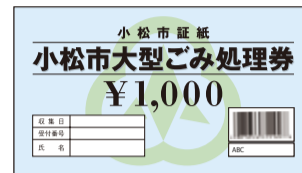
- Call Ecology Park to make an appointment.
Give the following information:
 - Type of item that will be disposed
 - Size
 - Your name, address and telephone number
 - Place where you will leave the item (must be in front of your house)
- Purchase a Voucher for Large-size garbage collection (Oogata gomi shori ken).
- Fill out the voucher (date of collection, name, reservation number).
Attach it on the item to be collected.

On the day of collection:

- Place the item to be collected in front of your house.
- Ecology Park workers will collect your garbage. *You do not need to be present at the time of collection. Garbage will be collected in the morning.

*If you take the garbage directly to the Ecology Park, please verify the fees on the table on the bottom-right (Large-sized garbage tickets are not needed).

- Reservation must be made at least 7 days prior to collection.
- Items that are under 50 cm in diameter or length can be disposed of at your community disposal area even if they are listed in the 83 items designated as Large-size garbage.
- Metal objects or items whose parts are mostly made of metal can be disposed of as Metals if they are under 150 cm in diameter or length.
- Except for the articles marked in red, items that fit into a 45L garbage bag can be disposed of at your community disposal area according to the appropriate category.
- Waste from offices and renovations is not eligible.
- The following items cannot be disposed of at the collection area even when they are under 50 cm in diameter or length: **dehumidifiers, microwave ovens, bicycles, tatami mats and household fireproof safes.**

Separate garbage before disposal
WORKING HOURS: Mon-Sat and public holidays
 Business hours 8:30-16:30 (disposal fee required)
CLOSED: on Sundays, 15 & 16 Aug, 31 Dec to 3 Jan
 Regulations for disposal at garbage processing center:
 * Ecology Park will not accept garbage not processed by the city
 * In cases with one-time large size garbage such as moving house, you cannot take the garbage to the disposal area so please consult with the garbage processing center.

* For small amounts of garbage, please follow collection schedule and dispose at collection sites instead.

Processing fee: 102 yen for every 10kg (rounded down to the nearest 100 yen denomination)
 *items with springs incur a surcharge of 500 yen per item
 *Pet (small animals) cremation is charged at 1000 yen/body.
 *No collection service. Please bring the remains over yourself.
 *Do not use cardboard boxes as waste containers or litter bins.
 * No collection on the following days:
 - general garbage: 1-3 Jan and Sundays
 - plastic containers and packaging: 1-3 Jan and Sundays
