

Regulations for disposal at garbage processing center:

Processing fee: 102 yen for every 10kg (rounded down to the nearest 100 yen denomination) *items with springs incur a surcharge of 500 yen per item

- * Pet (small animals) cremation is charged at 1000 yen/body. %No collection service. Please bring the remains over yourself.
- *Do not use cardboard boxes as waste containers or litter bins.
- * No collection on the following days:
