




- \* Ecology Park will not accept garbage not processed by the city
- \* In cases with one-time large size garbage such as moving house, you
- cannot take the garbage to the disposal area so please consult with the garbage processing center.

\*No collection service. Please bring the remains over yourself. \* Do not use cardboard boxes as waste containers or litter bins.

\*Pet (small animals) cremation is charged at 1000 yen/body.

- \* No collection on the following days:
- general garbage: 1-3 Jan and Sundays
- plastic containers and packaging: 1-3 Jan and Sundays

\*items with springs incur a surcharge of 500 yen per item
