# SEPARATION AND DISPOSAL OF DOMESTIC GARBAGE

Garbage which cannot be put out for collection or which cannot be taken to garbage processing centers Garbage which cannot be put

out for collection.

HARL items: Refrigerators • freezers, washing machines, televisions, letems which fall under the Household Appliance Recycling air conditioners, eletric (clothes) dryer Two-wheeled motor vehicles (including mopeds), computers

(including laptops and/or just the screen) Tires, fire extinguishers, batteries, gas canisters, oil heaters,

Containers with contents still included (cans, bottles, PET bottles) agricultural chemical bottles,

Tatami mats, wood chips, roof tiles, etc. from house remodelings Branches or logs that are bigger than 10 cm in diameter and longer than 50 cm in length.

Medical waste, such as syringes (tubes or needles).

The 83 items designated as Large-size garbage, items whose diameter or larger size are above 3 m, garbage from moving, one-time large scale garbage, Electone (organ), Piano.

All commercial garbage

Law (HARL)  $\rightarrow$  contact the store where the goods were purchased.

- For collection of personal computers, contact the manufacturer.
- For disposal of two-wheeled motor vehicles (including mopeds), contact the seller.
- Request collection of tires, fire extinguishers and batteries from the store of purchase
- Please ensure branches and logs are under 10 cm in diameter and no longer than 50 cm in length for disposal.
- Contact your local hospital or pharmacy for medical waste collection
- Take them to Ecology Park. Please make inquiries beforehand.
- Request collection of the designated large-size garbage or take it to Ecology Park.

Take general commercial waste to Ecology Park, or request collection by a collection firm, using designated commercial garbage bags. For Inquiries about Commercial Waste, please contact the Ecology Promotion Division

Please deposit garbage by 8:30 am on the day and Place of collection.

(Please ask the neighborhood association for information about your place of disposal).

- \* You cannot dispose of garbage in other districts.
- Collection vehicles differ depending on the type of garbage.
- \* Garbage disposal is not allowed after the designated time.
- \* No collection on the following days:
- general garbage: 1-3 Jan
- plastic containers and packaging: 1-3Jan

## Disposal warnings

- Drain excess water from kitchen waste.
- Soak up used cooking oil in waste paper or cloth.
- Notes, memos and (paper) sweet boxes that are bigger than a visit card can be recycled. Put them between the pages of a magazine or leaflet before disposal.
- Remove earth from grass before disposal.

Remove waste from paper diapers.

- For clothing disposal, place up to 2 bags at the collection point.
- Cut cord-shaped garbage down to 1m.

Only pruned branches, wood products, bamboo/bamboo products and tough vegetable stems can be tied with string instead of disposed in bags. Each item must be no more than 50cm long and 10cm wide. In total, wood and garden waste limited to 2 bags/bundles per disposal.

- Dispose of agricultural waste (stalks, leaves, vines, seeds) in the rice fields.
- As for clothing, there is a collection site at each paper recycling station (please refer to the blue box on the lower right side of this page).
- We ask for your cooperation in recycling cooking oil.
- \*The second Sunday of every month at Minami-shisho (Minowa-machi ha 84-2)
- \*The third Sunday of every month at Recycling Plaza (Mukaimotoori-machi he 88)
- \*Furugami recycle station (Ashida machi 2-7-1. From Mon. to Sat., from 8:30 to 16:30
- \*\*Check other recycling sites in your town

**PLASTIC CONTAINERS AND PACKAGING** 

Sweet wrappers, food bags, kitchen detergent or shampoo containers, strawberry or egg packs, cup noodle containers, trays, fruit protective packaging, plastic lids, PET bottle labels and caps, fruit netting.



(Bags will be torn apart inside the machinery, so please do not put the above items in separate smaller bags) Place **Plastic containers and packaging** separately from **General garbage** at disposal area.

- Suitable items display the ₹9€ mark.
- Please remove the cap from all containers.
- Clean items only.
- Make sure all items are completely dry before disposal.White trays to go to collection shops.
- Dirty items (ketchup or toothpaste tubes etc.), styrofoam and plastic items without the  $\Re$  mark are to be disposed as burnable garbage.

### Tie each type of paper with string. Separate paper by type at disposal area.

Remove flyers from newspapers.

- Newspapers should be tied up and not put in bags.
- Milk cartons should be washed, dried, cut opened, then tied with a string.
- Magazines, flyers and cardboard boxes should be tied up with a string.
- Papers larger than Business Card size shall be recycled with paper waste.



- Empty all packaging and rinse all cans with water.
- Exhaust all spray cans or tabletop cassette-style gas canisters in a well-ventilated place and puncture a hole in the side.





## **METALS**

Pans, kettles, frying pans, hot plates, oven toaster gas rice cookers, fan heaters, oil heaters, gas cookers, antennas, ski poles, golf clubs, sickles, knives, hoes.

- Remove batteries and kerosene from appliances before disposal.
- Glass lids must be disposed of as Landfill garbage.
- Heat treated metal and cast metal items are included in this category.
- Knives and blades must be wrapped with paper before disposal.





Electrical appliances Items made of mixed

Watches, vacuum cleaners, electrical fans, BS antennas, printers, word processors, portable sewing machines, lamps, electric rice cookers, umbrellas, belts, baby carriages/strollers, bags with metal parts, metal caps.

#### Place **Crush Garbage** and **Metals** separately from general garbage at disposal area.





 Remove batteries from appliances before disposal • If the internal part of the electric rice cooker is made of metal, the disposal of each part is on different days (the internal part goes with Metals and the external part goes as Crush garbage).

• Small rechargeable home appliances (with batteries that cannot be removed) fall under hazardous garbage.




#### Food /drink and medicine bottles must be separated by color.





- Cosmetics bottles must be disposed of as "Landfill Garbage".
- Take beer bottles (large, medium or small) and 1.8 liter bottles to collection shop.











#### Batteries Thermometers (and other items containing mercury)

### At the disposal area, place hazardous garbage separated according to the categories on the left.

- Fluorescent bulbs can break at the disposal area so please dispose of them in the original case.
- Button cell batteries and Nickel-Cadmium (NiCAD) batteries to be taken to recycle boxes in stores.







(Bags will get torn apart inside the machinery, so please do not put the above items in separate smaller bags).



- Suitable items display the 🗘 mark.
- Rinse lightly and make sure to remove cap and labels.
- PET bottles which were used for craft work are considered General garbage.
- Place undamaged PET bottles in bags and dispose.
- Caps and labels must be disposed of as Plastic containers and packaging.



- Ensure nails or needles are not scattered.
- Wrap sheet glass in paper and insert into a strong bag marked "KIKEN" (dangerous).

#### **How to request collection of Large-size garbage:**

Before collection (process may take up to a month after arranging for pick-up)

① Call Ecology Park to make an appointment. Give the following information:

- Type of item that will be disposed
- Your name, address and telephone number
- Place where you will leave the item (must be in front of your house)
- 2 Purchase a Voucher for Large-size garbage collection (Oogata gomi shori ken).
- ③ Fill out the voucher (date of collection, name, reservation number).

Attach it on the item to be collected.

#### On the day of collection:

- 4 Place the item to be collected in front of your house.
- 5 Ecology Park workers will collect your garbage. \*You do not need to be present at the time of collection. Garbage will be collected in the morning.

Please call us first

If you take the garbage directly to the Ecology Park, please verify the fees on the table on the bottom-right (Large-sized garbage tickets are not needed).

• Reservation must be made at least 7 days prior to collection.

• Items that are under 50 cm in diameter or length can be disposed of at your community disposal area even if they are listed in the 83 items designated as Large-size garbage.

· Metal objects or items whose parts are mostly made of metal can be disposed of as Metals if they are under 150 cm in diameter or length.

Except for the articles marked in red, items that fit into a 45L garbage bag can be disposed of at your community disposal area according to the appropriate category.

Waste from offices and renovations is not elegible.

•The following items cannot be disposed of at the collection area even when they are under 50 cm in diameter or length: dehumidifiers, microwave ovens, bicycles, tatami mats and household fireproof safes.
