

Proper Sewage Disposal Procedures (正しく使おうみんなの下水道)

Do not flush anything other than toilet paper into your toilet.

Tissue paper, paper diapers and hygiene products will get stuck in the pipes.

Do not throw vegetable bits or oil down the drains.

If organic waste and excess oil enters the sewage system, they will get stuck in the pipes and reduce the efficiency of the sewage treatment process. Please do not use a garbage disposal to throw your waste down the drain.

Do not flush specialist detergents that contain phosphorus and other volatile chemicals.

The treatment plant cannot completely take out the chemicals found in specialist detergents from the water. Please use only phosphorus-free detergent.

Do not wash down insoluble items such as garbage, soil, sand or snow.

Washing garbage, soil, sand, snow and other insoluble items down drains will cause blockage and the sewage to overflow onto the road.

Each household is expected to clean their own drainage pipes

The drainage pipe should be clean regularly. The cover should be opened and the inside flushed with water, and any solid matter should be removed during the cleaning.
