Points to note when redoing house drainage facilities (家庭の排水設備工事について)

What are drainage facilities?

Drainage facilities refer to the water pipes, basins and structures designed to bring waste water away from buildings or residences. In general use, it refers to the basin that water from kitchen, bathroom and sinks drain into.

Please only use designated shops when redoing your pipes

There are many laws, ordinances and guidelines to follow when constructing the pipes, please use the shops that have been approved by the city.

It is mandatory to follow the law on the following.

Systems connected to the sewers must have a drainage system as mandated by law.

It is required for a drainage system for the kitchen, bathroom and sinks to be installed within 6 months of the connection to sewer date.

Conversion from outhouse to sewer connected toilets must be done within 3 years.
